**Parade Committee Stand located at the corner of 90th St. and Leona Ave.**

**7:30 a.m.—Check in starts at the Parade Committee Stand and will close promptly at 8:30 am.**

Only the contact person for each entry need be present at this time. All other participants must be present by 8:30 a.m. After checking in you will be provided with your Parade Number and Position Assignment.

**8:45 a.m.— All vehicles and horse trailers must be at the end of the parade route by the Community Building by this time.**

We will have golf carts and ATV's available to bring you back to the Parade Committee Stand.

**For the safety of those gathered to view the parade, no participants will be allowed to drive into the parade area after 9:15 a.m. There will be no exceptions! We must keep this safe for everyone.**

9:15 am All contestants must be in their assigned places in order to qualify for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place judging in their category, which will begin at 9:20 am.

**ELIZABETH LAKE ROAD WILL CLOSE AT 9:30 a.m. and THE PARADE WILL START AT 10 a.m.**

Specialty Awards and Best of Parade will be judged during the parade and along the route. So keep shining those smiles and keep your parade wave strong!

**PLEASE REMEMBER!!! No objects, regardless of weight or size, including candy, toys and water balloons, may be thrown from the parade route.** If your group would like to hand out items along the route, this is more than welcome.
